In the words of the Prophet Isaiah, *"How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings glad tidings, announcing peace, bearing good news, announcing salvation, and saying to Zion 'Your God is King.'"*

For most of us, Christmas is a wonderful time of the year, the music, the colors, the warm and friendly spirit. No other time of the year is quite like it. There is a peace, a hope, a special feeling personal to all of us that can make us forget our worries and our troubles, at least for awhile.

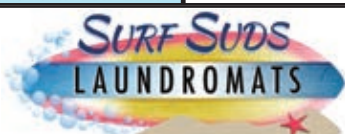

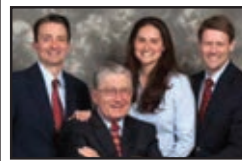
