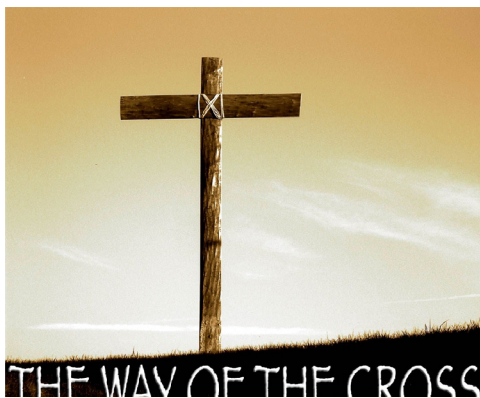

Bearing Gifts

When asked to bring up the gifts, you participate more deeply in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. The unleavened Bread and Wine that you carry will be consecrated to become the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. No rules but here are a few simple suggestions: when the ushers are returning from the first collection, gather at the back of the middle aisle with the gifts. When the priest celebrant comes to altar rail, begin up the aisle. Once all of the gifts have been presented to the priest, he may say a few words of thanks to the Gift Bearers, and then the Deacon or Altar Servers move to carry the gifts to the altar. A child who has not received First Holy Communion, and therefore does not yet grasp the sacredness of the Mass, should not carry any of the gifts, but is welcome to join his parents, grandparents or siblings who are presenting the gifts. It is always special to see parents with their children who represent the rest of us. The Gift Bearers, still standing in a line in front of the altar, bow slightly from the waist together toward the altar, turn and return down the aisle to their seats. The slight bow from the waist is out of respect for the Lord present in the tabernacle, the priest, who represents Jesus, Himself, at Mass, and the altar on which the same events of Calvary will soon be made present again.

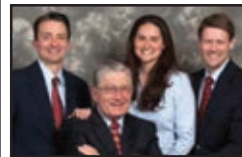
