#### **Fasting on Ash Wednesday**

Ash Wednesday marks the first day of the 40 days of Lent, dedicated to reflection, prayer, abstinence, and fasting in preparation for Easter. Lent ends on Holy Thursday, The Supper of the Lord, which is the fifth day of Holy Week.

On Ash Wednesday, if you are 18 to 59 years of age, you are obliged to fast by eating one full meal or two smaller meals. If you are 14 years of age or older, you are obliged to abstain from eating meat (except for health reasons).




