

Jacob's Well is known as the Well of Sychar located on the West Bank. An Orthodox Church was later built over and around the well. According to tradition, St. Photina is the name of the Samaritan woman whom Jesus encountered at the well. She is said to have become a believer in Jesus Christ, spreading the Gospel, and eventually being martyred in Carthage. However, the Orthodox Church believes she was summoned before the Emperor Nero and martyred by being thrown down a dry well in Rome. In the Roman Martyrology, her feast day is March 20th. In Oaxaca, Mexico, a celebration of the Samaritan woman takes place on the 4th Friday of Lent. Churches, schools, and businesses give away fruit drinks to anyone who passes by.

Seven Churches Visitation

After the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday

In preparation for the joy of Easter, the Catholic Churches of Cohort 19 invite you and your family to spend time in adoration, meditating on Christ's sacrifice of love for the salvation of souls. Holy Thursday is the feast that marks the end of Lent and the beginning of the Holy Triduum, which also includes Good Friday, Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday. At the end of the Holy Thursday Mass, the Eucharist is placed on a temporary "altar of repose" away from the sanctuary. It is customary for the faithful to spend time in quiet prayer and Adoration.

In the Roman Missal, it states: "The faithful are invited to continue adoration before the Blessed

Sacrament for a suitable length of time during the night, according to circumstance."

The Seven Churches Visitation is a tradition that grew out of this time of prayer and Adoration. Catholics remember when Jesus asked his disciples to stay and watch with Him while they were in the garden. This tradition of mindful watching is a sort of pilgrimage to various altars of repose, in different churches as we wait and pray, preparing ourselves during the time between the Last Supper in the Upper Room to His Crucifixion on the cross.

Diocese Issues Instructions for Liturgical Practices Amid Coronavirus Concerns

In light of the escalating concern about the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19) Bishop David M. O'Connell, C.M., has issued the following instructions on liturgical practices to be observed in ALL parishes, institutions and organizations within the Diocese of Trenton, effective immediately until otherwise notified:

- 1. People who have flu-like symptoms or who are otherwise feeling sick should not go to Mass or other Church gatherings.
- 2. Priests, deacons and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion should practice good hygiene, washing hands with soap and water or anti-bacterial hand sanitizer, before and after distributing Holy Communion.
- 3. People are encouraged not to receive Holy Communion on the tongue; worthy, reverent reception by hand is preferred until otherwise notified.
- 4. The practice of distributing the Precious Blood from the Chalice is suspended.
- 5. The practice of exchanging the sign of peace by any physical contact (handshake, embrace, kissing) is suspended.
