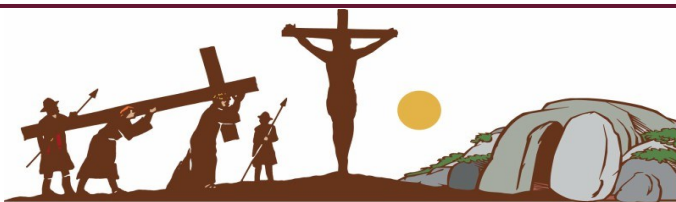

Eucharistic Adoration: The importance of Eucharistic Adoration is shown in the fact that the Church has a ritual that regulates it: the Rite of Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction. This is an extension of the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament which occurs in every Mass: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb." Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament flows from the sacrifice of the Mass and serves to deepen our hunger for Communion with Christ and the rest of the Church. The Rite concludes with the ordained minister blessing the faithful with the Blessed Sacrament. Please join us on Friday's immediately after the 7:30 AM Mass for Adoration. Benediction begins at 10:45 AM. It will also be broadcast on livestream @ stmarkseagirt.com. Come spend some quiet time with the Lord.

Reconciled (part II)

“So the woman goes off to love and be loved...with a love made perfect in Him. But where do all her accusers go? Some will follow her... and ask her to forgive them for despising her. In so doing, they, too, are re-born....and begin to walk the path of Saints.

Some will sit down and do nothing; only time will tell which path they will choose.

And then there are those whose hearts refuse to change...so hardened are they by doubt, fear and stone-cold bitterness. Perhaps, these are the ones for whom the loyal women of Jerusalem tried to console Him during His way of the cross.

But could they console Him even for those who would never forgive? Could they comfort Him for all those who would destroy souls by their lack of mercy? Could they give Him any measure of solace in amends for the destroyers of peace within His church today?

The ‘reconciled’ woman, and all her descendants since then, were the ones who gave Him that great measure of solace. So great in measure was it that He was able to bring His earthly body up to its feet again—not once—but three times!

So great was their love that it would sustain Him right up to the time that His Father would come to reclaim Him from that cross.

That cross, His cross, and the cross that it represent in all our lives. It is a heavy weight to carry. It is the cross that reconciled Him to us and us to Him.

Where am I in relation to that cross? How reconciled am I to the One that bore that cross in my name?”



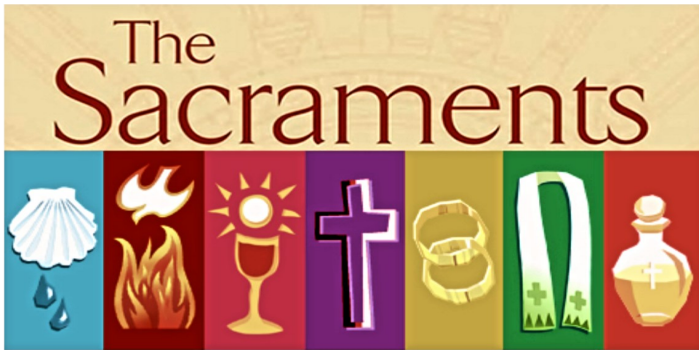

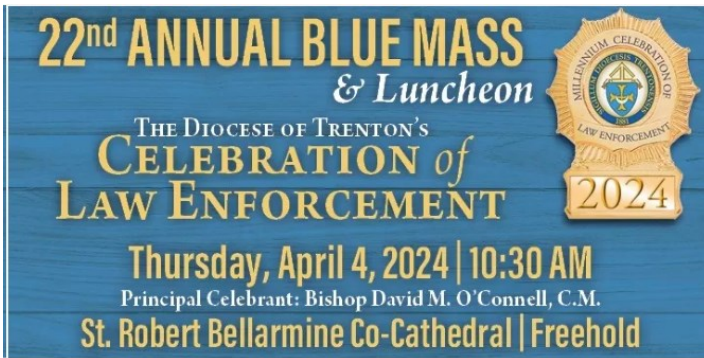

The process is simple! Here's what to do:

- Return the meals to the freezer compartment of the refrigerator in Fr. Child's Hall.
