

Simon of Cyrene actually helped Jesus carry His cross. Veronica, who had tremendous love for her suffering Jesus, ran to His side, knelt before Him and offered her veil to Him. The faithful women of Jerusalem were there as were Mary Magdalene and the most faithful Apostle John. Mary, the Holy Mother, stood by His side. “Beyond all human thought and

estimation was the sorrow of the most sincere Dove and Virgin Mother while She thus witnessed with her own eyes Her Son carrying the Cross to Mount Calvary; for She alone could fittingly know and love Him according to His true worth.” She sent this prayer to Him: “My Son and eternal God, light of My eyes and life of my soul, receive O Lord, the sacrifice of My not being able to relieve Thee of the burden of the Cross and carry it Myself, who am a daughter of Adam; for it is I who should die upon it in love of Thee, as thou now wishest to die in most ardent love of the human race.” Both quotes from “The Mystical City of God”



Caritas Chamber Chorale at St. Mark's Church



Who is Caritas? Where Are They From?

Caritas Chamber Chorale is not another parish choir. It is a special group of 22 finely tuned vocal musicians with a love for singing sacred choral music *a cappella* (see photo above). The singers are from various faith traditions and communities in central New Jersey. They are selected to join the Chorale based on voice excellence and singing experience

Caritas was organized as a performing Chorale in 2005 by Barbara Sanderman, its Director. The plan was to present a series of concerts for the enjoyment of people in their region and for the benefit of the Adorno Fathers' African Mission in Goma, the Congo, Caritas' charity. The performances were well received and it was decided to continue offering these beautiful programs. This year is their 20th Anniversary

The concerts were, and still are, free of charge & open to the public. Everyone is welcome! Freewill offerings are accepted and go entirely to the African Mission, which includes a nursery, primary school and orphanage. Currently the area surrounding the Adorno Mission is experiencing major violence from rebel forces taking control of Goma. Some of the Mission's buildings were damaged but none of the children were injured.

Caritas Chamber Chorale normally performs fresh, new concerts in the Spring and early Winter months, with a new theme each season. The theme for the concert they're performing for us here at St. Mark's next month is in its title: ***Grace for the Wayfarer***. Namely, from the lyrics and music, we hear once again that, through life's journey, God's crucial graces are always waiting for each one of us, and are available simply through our asking. (The lyrics are in the printed program, a keeper.)

Caritas Chamber Chorale will perform ***Grace for the Wayfarer*** at St. Mark's Church on Saturday, April 5, 2025 starting at 7:30PM. It's a relaxing Lenten event! Invite a friend to go with you. Enjoy.





Feeding the Hungry



Are you looking for an easy way to help those in need? Here's one way you can make a difference. St. Mark's Social Concerns Ministry is resuming the Frozen Meals Program for the Center in Asbury Park which was discontinued due to the Covid pandemic. The Center in Asbury Park, Inc., is a volunteer-based New Jersey not-for-profit service organization, providing support services for people living with HIV/AIDS and their caregivers since 1992.

The process is simple! Here's what to do:

- Pick up food trays and lids next to the kitchen refrigerator in Fr. Child's Hall (St. Mark's Church basement)
- Fill the trays with generous portions of food
- Label the tray lids with the contents and date of preparation
- Return the meals to the freezer compartment of the refrigerator in Fr. Child's Hall.
