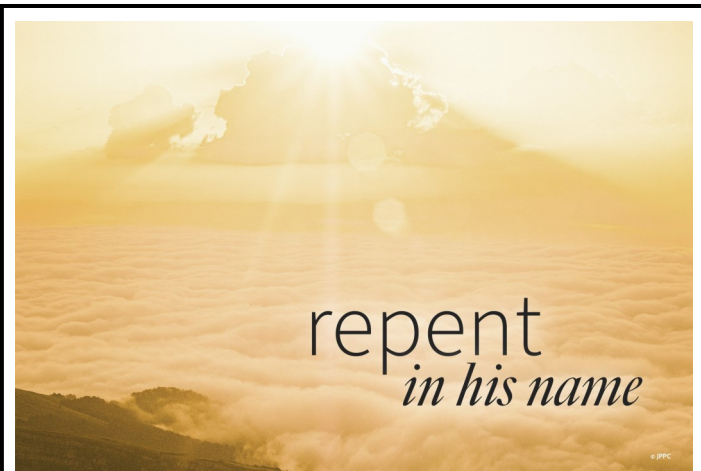

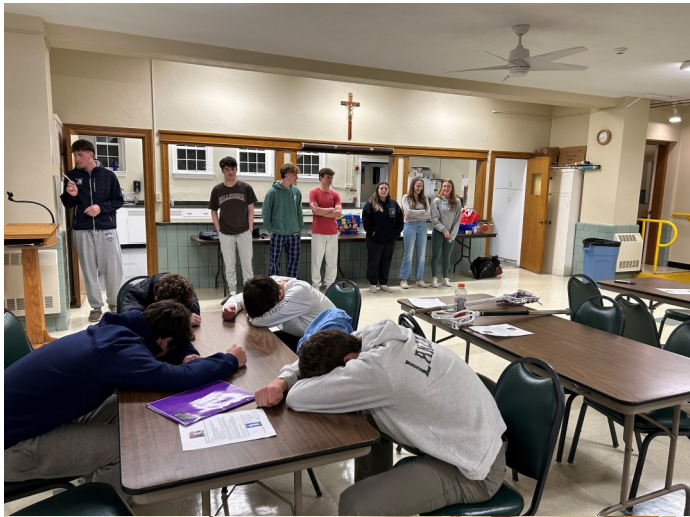

He made them look beyond their self-centeredness to embrace others who are often excluded. It's amazing how the courage and good example of just one person can influence so many others for the good!

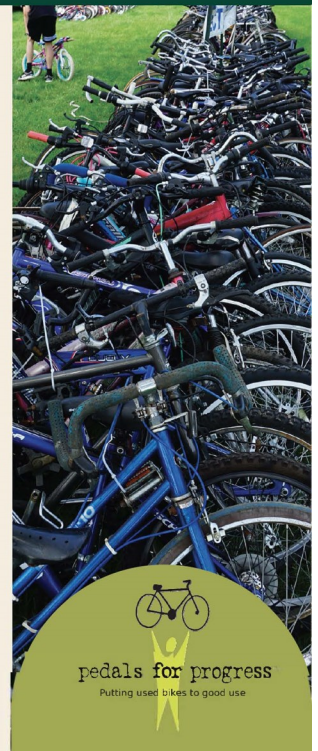

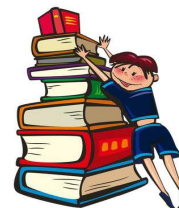
