
Invitation to Ministers:

A Prayer and Life Workshop is:

First. A method of learning how to pray. Where you learn to pray by praying. Step by step one learns how to enter into a personal relationship with the Lord, from the first steps to the depths of contemplation. In this manner, the Participants become transformed into friends and disciples of the Lord.

Second. Through the practice of faith and surrender and as a result of praying, almost without trying to, the Participant begins to heal the wounds of his heart, quiets his soul's anguish, and drives away his fear, controlling stress and experiencing great serenity. Sadness disappears and the joy of living is definitely recovered.

Third. But it does not end here. Contemplating the image of Jesus and imitating His characteristics, the Participant slowly begins to be transformed into a person who is patient like Jesus, understanding, meek, tender, and generous like Jesus.



Throughout the National Eucharistic Revival, local communities are gathering tinder in response to God's invitation for renewal, calling on the Holy Spirit to bring the flame.



The Department of Evangelization and Family Life is pleased to announce the 2024 Bishop's Anniversary Blessing for all couples celebrating a milestone anniversary of their Catholic Marriage. All couples celebrating their 1st. 25th or 50th (or more) anniversary in the 2024 calendar year are invited to attend. Anniversary couples must be validly married in the Catholic Church and registered members of a parish in the Diocese of Trenton.

The Bishop's Anniversary Blessing Mass for Monmouth County Parishes will be held on Sunday, October 6, 2024 at 3 pm at the Co-Cathedral of St. Robert Bellarmine in Freehold. - Return the meals to the freezer compartment of the refrigerator in Fr. Child's Hall.

Collecting Travel Size Toiletries




