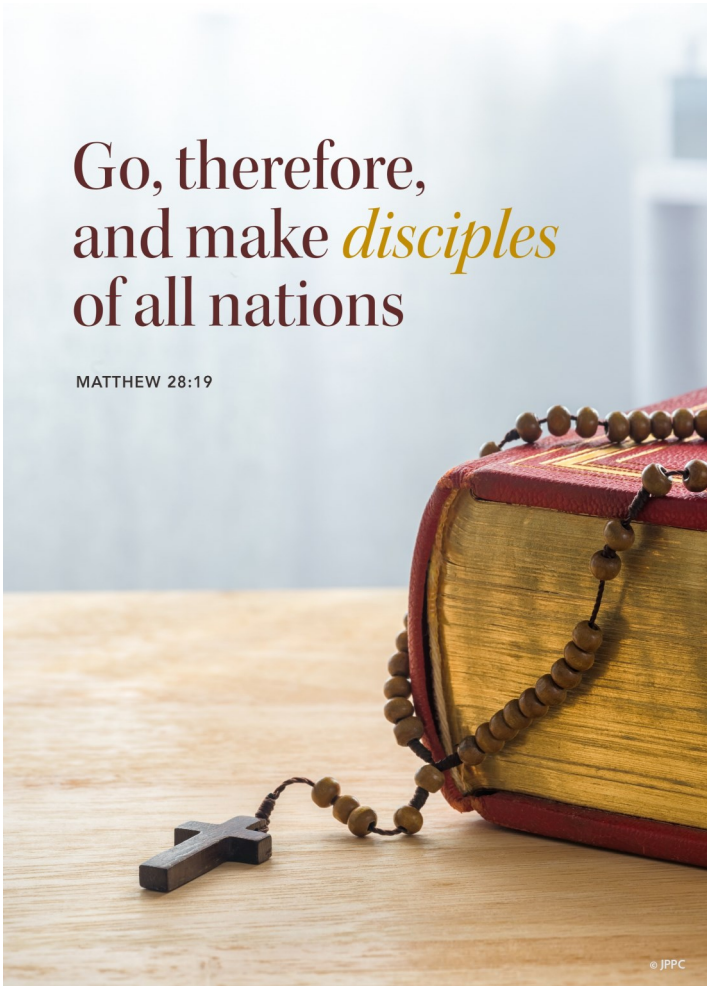

A Prayer and Life Workshop is:

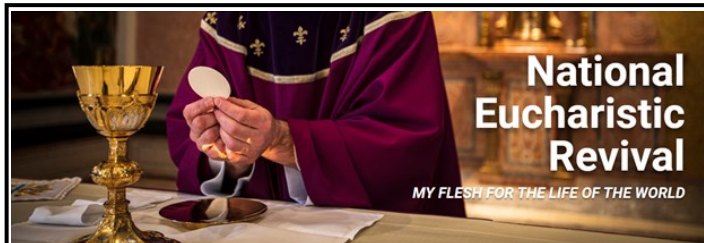

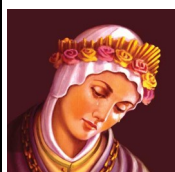
