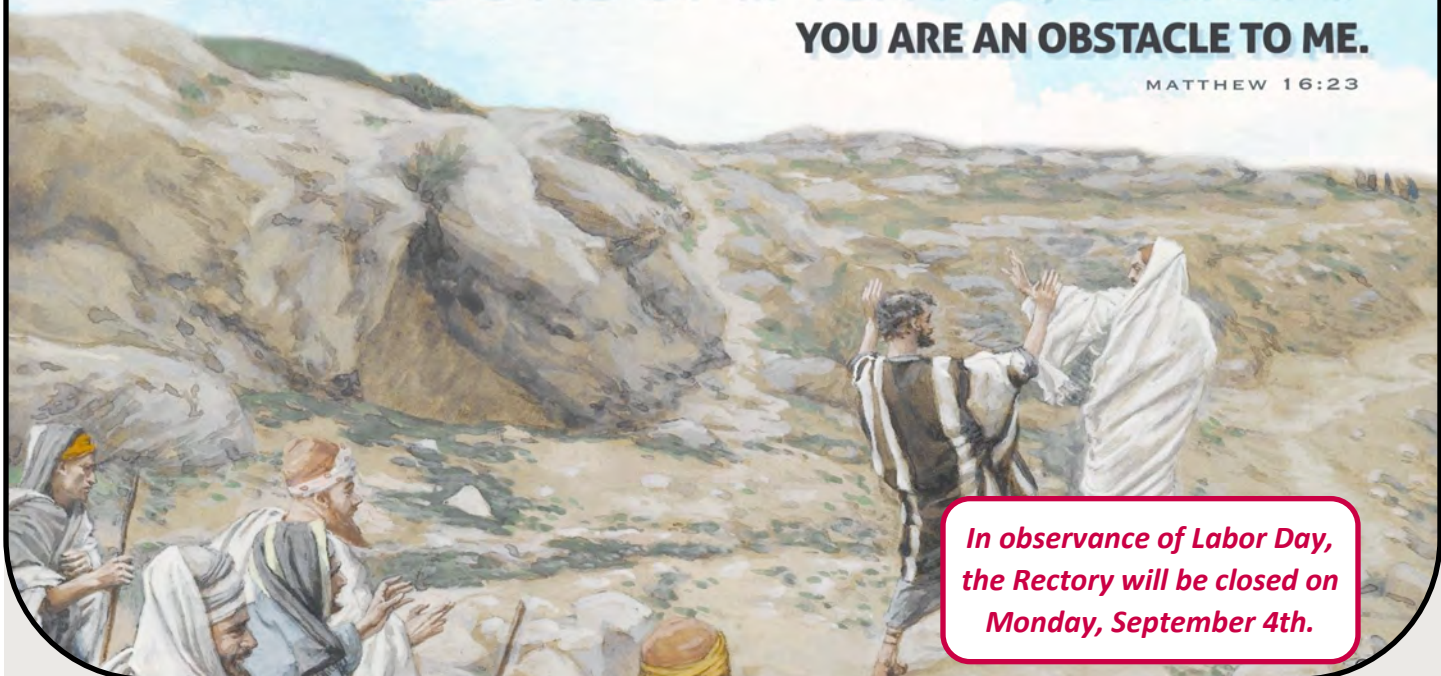

To me September is bittersweet. Its sad to see summer fading away, days getting shorter, vacations ending, enjoying being outside; yet there's the excitement of a new school season, autumn weather, fall holidays, and going for walks and so much more.

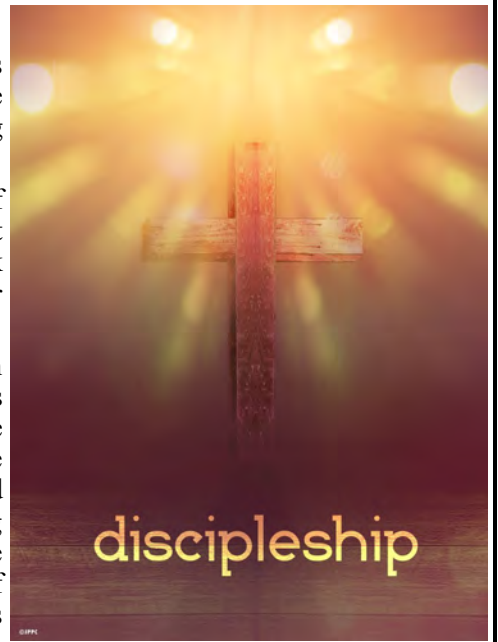
There are a lot of events this month. On the 8th we celebrate the birthday of our Blessed Mother. On the 11th, of course, we take time out to remember that very tragic day in 2001. We lift up to God all the souls that died and we ask God's healing for all the families that lost loved ones. We pray especially for our country. God please save the USA.

We celebrate Our Lady of Sorrows on the 15th and we pray each of the seven sorrows with her. We think of how saddened Mary was at the words of Simeon at the Presentation: "Your own heart a sword shall pierce." The second sorrow was when Joseph took Mary and Baby Jesus in the dark of the night away to the far land of Egypt to escape the murderous Herod. The third sorrow is the loss of the child Jesus when Mary and Joseph were returning home from Jerusalem. The fourth is when Mary met Jesus on the way of the cross. In the movie, "The Passion of the Christ," Jesus, under the weight of the cross, whispers to Mary, "See I make all things new." The fifth sorrow is Mary standing under the cross as Jesus breathes His last. Those of us that have lost children cry with Mary as our hearts break with Her. The sixth sorrow is Jesus taken down from the cross and laid in Mary's arms, and the seventh sorrow is the placing of Jesus in the tomb. Holy Mary, Mother of God pray for us sinners now, and at the hour of our death amen.

We celebrate St. Matthew this month on the 21st, and thank him for his gospel. I especially enjoy his infancy narrative. St. Matthew pray for us. We commemorate St. Padre Pio on the 23rd. 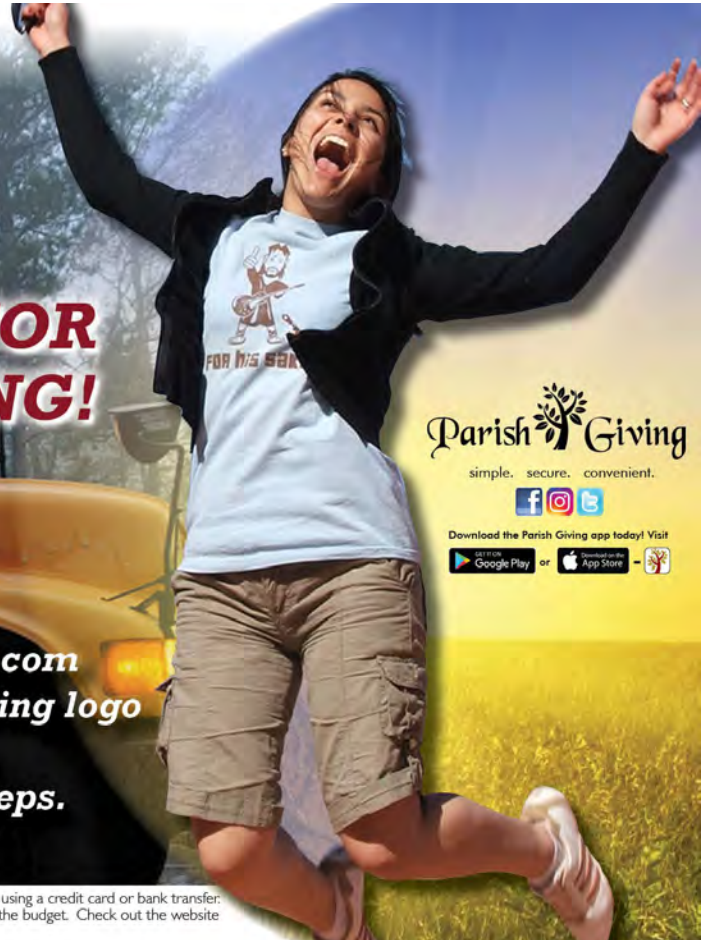

Social Concerns Programs

Feeding the Hungry



Are you looking for an easy way to help those in need? Here's one way you can make a difference. St. Mark's Social Concerns Ministry is resuming the Frozen Meals Program for the Center in Asbury Park which was discontinued due to the Covid pandemic. The Center in Asbury Park, Inc., is a volunteer-based New Jersey not-for-profit service organization, providing support services for people living with HIV/AIDS and their caregivers since 1992.

The process is simple! Here's what to do:

- Pick up food trays and lids next to the kitchen refrigerator in Fr. Child's Hall (St. Mark's Church basement)
- Fill the trays with generous portions of food
- Label the tray lids with the contents and date of preparation
- Return the meals to the freezer compartment of the refrigerator in Fr. Child's Hall.

Please use only the trays provided.

St Mark's volunteers will deliver the meals to The Center for distribution to their clients.
