The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Genesis 14:18-20 And Melchizedek, king of Salem, brought out bread and wine; he was priest of God Most High. Psalms 110:1-4: The LORD has sworn and will not change his mind, "You are a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek." 1 Corinthians 11:23-26:In the same way also the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

Luke 9:11b-17 And taking the five loaves and the two fish he looked up to heaven, and blessed and broke them, and gave them to the disciples to set before the crowd.

His name is mentioned at almost every Mass, all around the world, practically every minute of every day, in Eucharistic Prayer I, right after the consecration of bread and wine, "Look with favor on these offerings and accept them as once you accepted the gifts of your servant Abel, the sacrifice of Abraham, our father in faith, and the bread and wine offered by your priest Melchizedek."

Melchizedek is mentioned first in Genesis when Abram is returning to the land of Canaan after defeating King Chedorlaomer and three other rebel kings. He is congratulated for his victory by Melchizedek, King of Salem* (or Shalem which means Peace), who is called, "a priest of God Most High." The king offers this blessing, "Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth," and then gives bread and wine to Abram and his soldiers. In turn, Abram gives Melchizedek 1/10th of his spoils from the defeated kings.

A tenth was, according to the general custom, the offering presented to God.

In Hebrews, St. Paul uses the absence of recorded parentage for Melchizedek to explain how Jesus could also be both King and High Priest as foreshadowed in the Old Testament The Hebrews would understand that Melchizedek was honored as a king and a priest by their father Abraham, and that he did not have an earthly father but a Heavenly Father lineage to the priesthood. So, Jesus is a High Priest in the order, or in the same way, that Melchizedek was. Msgr. Flynn and Fr. Jose who also answered the call from God to the priesthood, received Holy Orders which are forever.

*Later Salem (or Shalem) became Yerushalem or Jerusalem. The word "Yeru" means "foundation stone" or "cornerstone." The name Jerusalem, then, means "the foundation stone of Salem" and refers to the cornerstone laid by the Creator of the Universe when He built the Earth.

NJ Independent Victims Compensation Program is Open

As had been announced in February of this year, the Diocese of Trenton—along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey—has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as minors, were sexually abused by a priest or deacon of the Diocese. The IVCP was open to claims beginning June 15.

The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros. Mr. Feinberg was the plan administrator for the federal 9/11 victim compensation program, as well as the Boston Marathon bombing compensation program.

The IVCP will handle the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and will operate independently of the Diocese or any Church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP will have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims—no matter when the abuse occurred—are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to www.njdiocesesivcp.com and reviewing the Protocol for submitting a claim.

Anyone who was sexually victimized as a minor by a priest or deacon of the Diocese is strongly encouraged to participate in the IVCP. The Diocese also asks that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to pass along this information to the victim so that he or she is aware of the IVCP.


