### An Update from Cohort #19



### Faith in Our Future Planning Initiative

Cohort 19 team representatives from the parish communities of St. Mark in Sea Girt, St. Catharine-St. Margaret in Spring Lake, St. Rose in Belmar, and St. Teresa in Bradley Beach/Avon continue to meet and collaborate on setting and implementing specific goals for our Cohort as part of the *Faith in our Future Planning Initiative* launched by the Diocese of Trenton in 2016. Here is a quick summary of our activities to date:

- ★ Cohort 19 submitted our 3<sup>rd</sup> Year Implementation report to the Diocesan Planning Commission in mid-May that detailed our progress during the past year along with an outline of our strategic priorities for the 2019-20 period. We expect to hear back from the Commission within the next week and will share that feedback in a subsequent update.
- ★ A luncheon was held on May 7<sup>th</sup> for all parish staff members within Cohort 19 to improve communication and to share best practices. Our respective Parish Councils and Pastoral Councils will also be getting together later this fall to continue this important strategic priority.
- ★ A Cohort 19 Mass will be held at the Gazebo in Belmar on September 10<sup>th</sup>, at 10 AM, with Bishop O'Connell. Music for the Mass will be coordinated by the music directors from each of our 4 parishes. Youth volunteers are needed for both event setup and cleanup and we also need Sacristans, Altar Servers, Lectors, Co-Celebrants, and Eucharistic Ministers from each of the 4 parishes. Please look for additional details in your respective Parish Bulletins on how you can help make this a successful event.
- ★ Cohort 19 is planning to hold a Lenten Mission in March 2020 and will likely involve a 3 night, Monday-Wednesday evening format. Please stay tuned for additional details in the months ahead.
- ★ We continue to need volunteers at St. Mark's Center for Hispanic Ministry, especially for youth between 16-18 years of age who can help with such activities as arts and crafts and holding classes in English and in cooking. ## MISSION APPEAL 2019: Archdiocese of Onitsha, Nigeria

*Preacher: Rev. Fr. Charles C. Muorah, PhD, STL, PGDE, LMFT*



The Church of Onitsha Archdiocese is on the east coast of Nigeria.

Nigeria is the largest country in Africa with a population of about 192 million people. Nigeria is approximately three times the size of Germany. Nigeria is about 50% Christian and the east coast is approximately 98% Christians. Onitsha metropolis has a geographical area of 1,146 square miles and a population of about 3 million people; Catholics are about 2.2 million.

The Church of Onitsha Archdiocese is blessed with rich vocations to the priesthood and religious life. During his pastoral visit to Nigeria in February 1982, Pope John Paul II, now a saint, directed the Archbishop of Onitsha to start sending priests on mission to other parts of the world. Today, about 42 priests from the Archdiocese serve in different parts of Nigeria, four in other dioceses in Africa, 20 in Europe, and 61 in North America. In recent times, there is a renewed systematic attack on Christians by the Muslim radicals. The activities of Boko Haram and the Fulani Muslim Herdsmen, and the silence of the Federal Government of Nigeria suggest both religion and ethnic cleansing. Priests and the congregations are killed at Mass and the seminarians and clergy staff go to bed fearing if they will wake up in the morning. Nuns are kidnapped in their nightgowns at night and women/girls are raped and slaughtered like animals.



Trails of destruction of property and the farms of Christian dominated areas in Nigeria is beyond imagination. The slogan is: let their blood flow like a river into the Atlantic Ocean and use their churches as barns for cattle. Nigeria is the heartbeat of Africa. If they succeed Nigeria would become a haven of terrorists jeopardizing security and peace in Africa, North America and the whole world. Your generous gift will empower the Church of Onitsha Archdiocese to continue with its mission of defending the Christian faith and addressing the humanitarian crisis being generated by this modern form of persecutions of the Church and Christians.

Fr. Muorah was ordained a priest of the Onitsha Archdiocese in Nigeria on July 13, 1991. He served there as an Associate Pastor, a Parish Administrator and then a Founding Pastor. He was appointed the Director of Trinitas School of Evangelization of Onitsha Archdiocese and as the Principal Instructor at the Emmaus School of Evangelization for West Africa.

He was the Founding Director of Poor in our Midst, an Archdiocesan social services organization, and also the Director of the Onitsha Archdiocesan Jubilee Year. He taught two years in the Archdiocesan seminary and gave many speeches on television and radio. Fr. Muorah came to the United States in 2001 and was incardinated into the Diocese of Trenton on July 22, 2011. He served at St. Mary of the Lakes, Medford, from 2001 to 2007, and St. Isaac Jogues, Marlton, from 2007 to 2016. He is currently the Parochial Vicar at Sacred Heart in Trenton. He is profoundly experienced in pastoral, teaching, and media ministries as well as preaching parish and group missions. He is well learned in theology and the social sciences, the beauty of which is seen in his pastoral ministries. This is the experience he brings with him to our Parish to preach the 2019 Mission Cooperation plan between the Trenton Diocese and Onitsha Archdiocese, Nigeria.

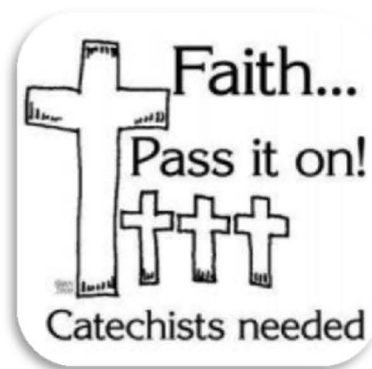

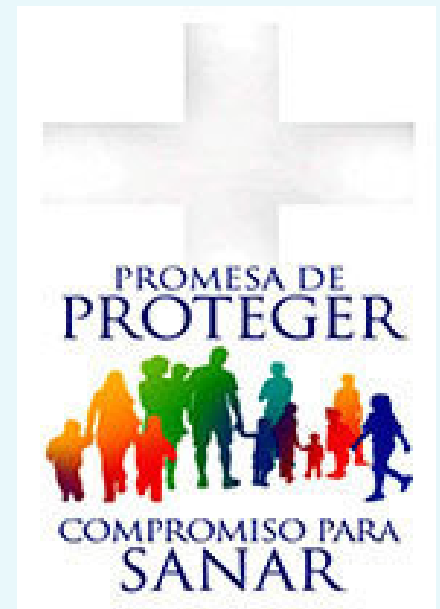

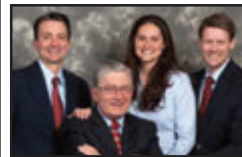
