

Reading I Is **60:1-6**

Rise up in splendor, Jerusalem! Your light has come, the glory of the Lord shines upon you.

See, darkness covers the earth, and thick clouds cover the peoples; but upon you the LORD shines, and over you appears his glory.




St. Elizabeth and St. John please pray for all our school systems, as parents struggle and fight for their right to have their voices heard as to the content and sway of the curriculum.




Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton Feast Day Mass & Celebration
